"It is in very high demand," notes Jen St. Michael, RVH Senior Physiotherapist. "We really truly appreciate this—it will be well used." The committee directed the remaining funds towards new furniture for the gazebo that is part of the Healing Garden at the front of the hospital.

"We realize that a tranquil, stress-free space away from tests and procedures is also an important aspect of healing," says Reverend McFarlane.
