Growth

- Development of a health care campus
- Expanded Assisted Living Program began in 2013, doubled in 2023 with 10 clients added in Renfrew area in 2023, plus Calabogie and Eganvile/Cobden added to service area
- Implementation of Physician Assistant role in Emergency Department and on Complex Continuing Care Unit
- New regional nephrology wing to support growth of program and trickle effect to other areas of the hospital (i.e., new pharmacy, updated oncology unit)
