RENFREW HEALTH: PROJECT FUNDING SUPPORT

Fact Sheet

Since the inception of Renfrew Health (RH) in 2014, it has made major investments in property, renovations, new construction, equipment and human resources to help ensure that Renfrew Victoria Hospital (RVH) is able to provide quality health care services close to home. These investments by RH have helped to fill gaps in services and have benefitted thousands of patients in our community. Through the skilled and experienced management of RH, which was created for the sole purpose of benefitting RVH, governance and financial risks to the hospital and RVH Foundation (RVHF) are greatly reduced.

Over the past nine years, projects funded wholly or in part by RVH and its partners, including RVHF and RH include:

- 23,000 square foot world-class Regional Nephrology Centre
- Upgraded/modernized Oncology Unit
- 16,000 square foot Medical Professional Building at 100 Health Village Lane which houses family physicians as well as care services including chiropractors, laboratory and RVH Sleep Products
- State-of-the-art, 128-slice CT scanner

- Women's Health/Gynecology, Neurology specialist clinics
- Surgical partnership with TOH
- EPIC electronic health information system
- Physician recruitment success
- New X-Ray equipment and upgraded suite
- Refurbishment of the Emergency Department

Planned projects in the next five years

RVH will continue to grow and expand with the support of our partners to meet the needs of our community.

CAPITAL PROJECTS

RVH is working with its funding and other partners to bring an added MRI scanner to the region. This project will require significant local funds to construct the required space and purchase the MRI equipment

RVH is also continuing to plan for a redevelopment of the inpatient areas of the hospital. If approved, our community would be responsible for its local share of this large project.

EQUIPMENT NEEDS

Having the most up-to-date equipment is essential to providing quality care from diagnosis to procedures and treatment as well as recruiting and retaining patient care staff and physicians. Over the next five years, we anticipate that equipment needs totalling over \$3 million will include CT Scan replacement and other diagnostic and monitoring equipment will be at end of their life cycle. The hospital and its partners (RH, RVHF) are fully responsible for the costs of these ongoing equipment needs.
